Sir,

The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has received online application (Part-1) seeking permission for student intake in Under Graduate (BHMS) course with student intake of 75 seats for the academic year 2022-23.

2. As per provision of NCH Act, 2020 Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MA&RBH) has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission for student intake to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform that Part-1 Performa and all the relevant documents submitted by your college were examined as per the existing regulations.

3. On scrutiny and careful consideration of your documents and further observations of the Board, the following shortfalls are found to be addressed for granting permission for student intake in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23:

A. Hospital Staff: Attendance and salary statement of Secretarial staff, staff for IPD registration is not available for verification.

B. Teaching Faculty: Professor is not available in Department of Organon of Medicine.

4. After considering the provisions of NCH Act, 2020 the conditional permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to **Shri Takhatmal Shrivallabh Homoeopathic Medical College, & Hospital, Homoeo Sadan Rajapeth, Amravati, Maharashtra-444606 with student intake of 75 seats in UG (BHMS) course for the academic year 2022-23.** The College Principal is directed to fulfill all deficiencies within a period of 1 month. An affidavit from Principal shall be submitted in this regard to MARBH within one week from the date of issuance of this letter.

5. As per section no. 43 of the NCH Act 2020, vide letter no. Y-11011/4/2022-EP-III dated 14/10/2021, Central Govt. has taken a policy decision that all admission shall be through NEET only with qualifying marks/ 50 percentile.

6. All admissions in Under Graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota.



The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

7. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed.

8. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules. The College has to comply with the full requirements as per NCH Act, 2020 for conducting the course.



Sir,

As Central Government by notification, constituted a Commission, to be known as the National Commission for Homoeopathy, to exercise the powers conferred upon, and to perform the functions assigned to it, under NCH Act 2020. As per section 59 (2) of NCH Act, 2020, following has been stated:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act 1973, the educational and medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder: Provided that anything done or any action taken as regards the educational and medical standards and requirements under the enactment under repeal and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provision of this Act and shall continue in force accordingly unless and until superseded by anything or by any action taken under this Act".

As per provision in the Act, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has been constituted with the mandate to grant permission to the existing and new medical institution of Homoeopathy. Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

2. On careful consideration of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has arrived at the following conclusion:

That the applicant has set up a Homoeopathic Medical College with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to implement Minimum Standard Requirements of the Homoeopathy College and attached Hospital as prescribed by the National Commission for Homoeopathy for conducting BHMS course in Homoeopathy.

A. Hospital staff: Gardner and Sweeper not available.

B. Teaching faculty.

For UG courses: Total 27 full time faculty provided by college and 25 found eligible.

Discrepancies found in engagement of Teachers are as under:

1. Dr. Arpit Baburao Nimbhorkar, Lecturer, Pharmacy: Previous teaching experience as Lecturer in Pharmacy from 16-01-2019 to 6-6-2020 and Joined as reader on 6-6-2020, 4 years teaching experience as lecturer not available
2. Dr. Poonam Sachin Bhattad (Reader- Community Medicine) - She Joined as Lecturer in Community Medicine on 01-06-2016 but she doesn't have the MD

degree. This time filled date of joining as Lecture 31-5-2006 (In PJNHMC, Amravati) in affidavit but no document is provided for the verification.

3. **Guest faculty:** Guest Faculty as Reader, Materia Medica, Reader in Pathology, Reader, Organon, Professor, Pathology and Reader, Obstetrics and Gynaecology previous teaching experience not provided.

C. The college has provided 14 Guest Faculty and total 08 found eligible.

D. The consultants of modern medicines not available in the college as all claimed Part Time Teachers are common in Guest faculty.

E. **Miscellaneous:** Form 16 of only 5 teachers available, Form 16 of non-teaching and hospital staffs not provided. Dr. Jyoti Bapurao, Dr. Nitin Parkhi, Dr. Vaishali, Dr. Truptinad, Dr. Rani (receiving salary less than 10000/month). Name of Gardner and Sweeper –Not available in attendance and aquittance roll.


3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, Conditional permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to Shri Takhatmal Shrivallabh Homeopathic Medical College, Homoco. Sadan, Rajapeth, Amravati – 444606, Maharashtra for continuing admissions in I- BHMS course with intake capacity of 75 seats in UG (BHMS) course, for the academic year 2021-22. The Principal is directed to fulfill the deficiencies within three months and an affidavit in this regard may be submitted to the Medical Assessment Board within a period of one week.

4. All admissions in Under Graduate/Post graduate course shall be through NEET only. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counseling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the student admitted thereunder.

5. The category wise list of selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board as per rules.

6. The college has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for conducting the course. All deficiencies observed and mentioned above which affects the performance of the academic Institution, through which College fails to fulfill the statutory requirements, has to be rectified within three months time from issue of this permission letter. Compliance report shall be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board accordingly. Subsequently, the Board shall verify the compliance well in time and may conduct Online/Physical inspection for verification of compliance as per the HCC (MSR) Regulation, 2013 and will consider admissions for the academic year 2022-23.




I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats in UG (BHMS) course at Shri Takhatmal Shrivallabh Homeopathic Medical College, Homoeo Sadan Rajapeth-Maharashtra, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F.No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 3051 dated 14.10.2020 as under:-


"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with intake capacity of 75 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course."

The committee also recommended to appraise Ministry that the college does not have updated website, small deficiency in hospital equipment, and higher faculties in the Dept. of Community Medicine. Details of ineligible teachers are as under:

- Dr Jyoti Prakash (Prof. Pharmacy)-Not considered eligible as age exceeded 65 years (DOB: 06-04-1954)*
- Dr Kanchan Subhash Bagde (lecturer, Surgery)-Not considered eligible as age exceeded 65 years (DOB- 11-03-1953).*
- Dr Poonam Sachin Bhattad (Reader, CMD)- Not considered eligible as she joined as Lecturer in CMD 01-06-2016 without MD degree."*

2. 2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of Shri Takhatmal, Shrivallabh Homoeopathic Medical College, Homoeo. Sadan, Rajapet, Amravati - 444605, Maharashtra on 20.07.2016 and not recommended for taking admission in 2016-17.

3. The Central Government while examining the inspection report of CCH in terms of the provisions of HCC (MSR), 2013 has observed that the college is not fulfilling the following basic eligibility conditions:

- (i) Professor not appointed in Organon of Medicine, FMT, Community Medicine and Repertory. Reader not appointed in Physiology. Lecturer Anatomy not qualified at the time of appointment. His registration no. is 33241 dated 08.05.2002 and date of appointment is 09.06.2003. Dr. Madhuri Chhawsaria Lecturer Pharmacy, who's name is present both in the list of teaching staff and Medical Officer Post. Her name is also not in the teaching Time Table. Dr. Pallavi Dhole reader Forensic Medicine was not qualified at the time of appointment because her registration no. is 3367 dated 11.10.2002 and date of first appointment is 21.07.2003. No classes are allotted in the time table for Dr. V.S. Manekar Professor in the department of surgery. Dr. P.D. Tapadia name's is both in Professor Repertory and Senior Medical Officer also no classes are allotted in the time table for him.
- (ii) RMO, Radiologist, Pathologist/Bio-chemist, House Physicians, X-ray Technician/Radiographer, Dresser and dietician are not appointed.
- (iii) The average daily patients attended OPD 106 per day against the require 200 as per HCC(MSR), 2013. OPD records were poorly maintained. Medicine Dispensing Register was not present.
- (iv) The average daily bed occupancy is 24.37% against the require number of 30% as per HCC(MSR), 2013.
- (v) X-ray, ECG and USG not available.
- (vi) Equipments provided in various department are not as per HCC (MSR), 2013.

4. In view of the above pointed out deficiencies, you are hereby given an opportunity of hearing as a natural justice of being heard in terms of provisions of the first proviso to subsection 4 of section 12 A of the HCC Act, 1973 at 10.30 AM on 9.9.2016 before the designated Hearing Committee in the Ministry of AYUSH. You are given an opportunity to present your case and to show cause as to why the admission should not be stopped in BHMS course for the academic year 2016-17 as per the provisions of HCC (MSR), 2013.

5. It is further directed that you may bring along and submit all possible oral and written submissions with valid documents/records/proof to substantiate your claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above during hearing for evidence/verifications by the Central Government.

(a) Original/attested Documents in support of the Qualifications, Registration Certificate, Previous teaching experience, Appointment order, Joining report, Attendance register, Class time table, Bio metric Attendance sheet, Salary register, Form 16, leave register etc. to prove the existence of full strength of teaching faculty and hospital staff may be produced.

(b) Original purchase vouchers, Procurement Stock Register, Issue Register, in support of the availability of instruments/equipments in various departments of the College and Hospital may be produced.




Sir,

This has reference to this Department's letter of even number dated 26th August, 2013, wherein amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 was granted for the academic year 2013-14 for all existing Homoeopathy Colleges. Accordingly, CCH was requested to inform all the existing Homoeopathy Medical Colleges and also direct the colleges to ensure compliance of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 and accordingly remove all the shortcomings as required for getting conditional permission for the subsequent academic session 2014-15 as per the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013.

In light of the visitations done by CCH from 1st January, 2014 onwards, the Central Government during preliminary discussions with CCH had come to the understanding that most of the Homoeopathy Medical Colleges are still not able to comply with the requisite norms as required under the HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for obtaining conditional permission for the session 2014-15. Further, in absence of enabling provision in the HCC Act, 1973 for granting permissions on annual basis to the existing colleges, the amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 is being granted for the academic




